

CHAPTER 21 - POLICE

Sec. 21-44. Alarm systems; regulations.

(a) Each alarm system shall be inspected and serviced at least once in each twelve month period. The subscriber or proprietor shall maintain records for each system showing dates of inspection and the name of the person making such inspection. Records shall be kept for a minimum of twelve (12) months and be open to the Police Chief or his designee on his request upon seventy two (72) hours notice served by U.S. Mail or any other means reasonably calculated to provide notice.

(b) It shall be unlawful for any person to intentionally activate any alarm system, except to warn of a criminal act or unauthorized entry on or into an alarm protected premises, or to test an alarm system when the police department has been given advance notice of such testing.
