

CHAPTER 23 – STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS

Sec. 23-52. Construction; permit application; fees.

(a) All applications to the city for a permit to construct driveways, streets, sidewalks, curbs, gutters, traffic signals, street lights, traffic signs, pipe lines, to widen the paved roadway, to cut pavement, sidewalks, curbs, gutter or to repave pavement cuts, shall be in writing on a form promulgated by the city and shall be accompanied by at least one copy of a plot plan showing the size of the property, the location with reference to lot and street lines of existing proposed buildings, driveways, curbs, sidewalks, trees, poles or other objects that might affect the work.

(1) The application shall include a Traffic Control Plan that shall identify whether Traffic Control will be necessary by police assistants or certified peace officers and shall be submitted to the Police Department for review. Any individual providing traffic control in a City of Peoria right of way, street, road, parkway or easement shall be clearly identified in the uniform of a law enforcement officer. The application shall indicate if reserve or posse officers are proposed to be used. The Police Department may prohibit the use of reserve or posse personnel on any any project. Violations of this prohibition shall result in immediate revocation of the permit by the City. This provision shall be included in each permit issued by the City.

(b) All applications shall include a permit and plan review fee to cover the city's cost of plan review, inspection and issuing the permit. The fee shall be in the amount set forth in Chapter 2 of this code. No part of the permit and plan review fee shall be refundable.
