

CHAPTER 23 – STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS

Sec. 23-47. Sidewalks; specifications.

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person, whether owner, contractor or otherwise to lay or cause to be laid any sidewalk on any public street or alley unless such sidewalk shall be laid according to the plans for such work as approved by the city and in accordance with the specifications approved by the city and such standards and guidelines promulgated under this chapter and under permit and inspection by the city.

(b) Notwithstanding subsection (a) of this section a party who has constructed a sidewalk that is under warranty to the city may replace damaged or broken sections of the warrantied sidewalk in accordance with the previously approved plans and specifications.
