

CHAPTER 23 – STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS

Sec. 23-56. Duty of person to repair street.

It shall be the duty of every person working in the public right of way who causes any damage to the public street to repair the street in accordance with city standards, specifications and guidelines, under city permit, review and inspection and in such manner that it is returned as nearly as practicable to its original condition and maintain the repair for a period of time of not less than one year after repairing the street.
