

CHAPTER 23 – STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS

Sec. 23-7. Protection of excavations, summary action by City, lien upon property; violations; classification.

(a) It is unlawful to make any excavation or dig any hole, drain or ditch in any highway or thoroughfare without providing a sufficient light at night and a temporary fence or suitable obstruction in accordance with the barricading standards adopted by city or promulgated by the Engineering Director, around or in front of such excavation during the day.

(b) It is unlawful to maintain a well, cellar, pit, or other excavation of more than (2) feet in depth on any unenclosed lot, without substantial curbing, covering or protection.
