

## CHAPTER 23 – STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS

Sec. 23-95. Telecommunications; rights of way; rights reserved to City.

Without limitation upon the rights which the city might otherwise have, the city does hereby expressly reserve the following rights, powers and authorities:

(a) To exercise its governmental powers now or hereafter to the full extent that such powers may be vested in or granted to the city.

(b) To determine any question of fact relating to the meaning, terms obligations, or other aspects of this ordinance and the permit.

(c) To grant multiple, nonexclusive licenses, franchises or permits within the city to other persons for the operation of telecommunication systems
