

CHAPTER 25 - WATER, SEWERS AND SEWAGE DISPOSAL

Sec. 25-175. Control manholes.

When required by the Director, the owner of any property served by a building sewer carrying potentially harmful or industrial wastes shall install a suitable control manhole in the building sewer to facilitate observation, measurement, and sampling of the wastes. Control manholes shall be required for all New Source interceptors. Such manholes, when required, shall be accessible and safely located and shall be constructed in accordance with plans approved by the Director. The manhole shall be installed by the owner at his expense and shall be maintained by him so as to be safe and accessible at all times.
