May 20, 2008

A **Regular Meeting** of the City Council of the City of Peoria, Arizona was convened at 8401 West Monroe Street in open and public session at 7:00 p.m.

Adopted **ORD. 08-12** to amend Chapters 2 and 15 of the Peoria City Code (1992 Edition) to provide for a Judicial Selection Advisory Board.

3C Establish New Classifications

At the request of staff, this Agenda Item related to the recommendation of the Personnel Review Committee regarding the establishment of new classifications in the Information Technology Department and Police Department was removed from the Agenda to be brought back before the Council at a later meeting yet to be determined. No Council action was taken.

4C Grant, Maricopa County Attorney, RICO (Racketeer Influenced and Corrupt Organization) Funds

- a) Accepted RICO Fund grants from the Maricopa County Attorney's Office in the amount of \$18,720 for Criminal Division contract attorney services (LCON12608); and in the amount of \$2,557.27 to help the Arizona Coalition for Victim's Services to pay for their annual Arizona Victim Assistance Academy (LCON12708); and
- b) Approved budget transfers from the General Fund Contingency Account in the amount of \$18,720 to the State Anti-Racketeering, City Attorney Forfeiture Contract Labor Account; and in the amount of \$2,558 to the State Anti-Racketeering - City Attorney Forfeiture City Participation, Outside Programs Account to provide additional expenditure authority for the grant funds in Fiscal Year 2008.

5C Intergovernmental Agreement, Peoria Unified School District, Education Channel

Authorized the City Manager to execute an intergovernmental agreement granting use of the education channel by the Peoria Unified School District. (LCON12808)

6C Contract, Kiewit Western Company, Beardsley Road Extension, 83rd Avenue to Loop 101

Awarded a contract for an amount not to exceed \$199,818 to Kiewit Western Company for construction manager at risk services associated with the construction of the Beardsley Road extension, 83rd Avenue to State Route 101L (Phase I) (LCON12908).

7C Contract Amendment, Accela, Inc., Development Permitting Software System

Approved a contract amendment in the amount of \$125,060 with Accela, Inc. for professional services to develop additional automation of functionality within the new development permitting system. (LCON03107C)

8C Contract Amendment, Project Engineering Consultants, Ltd., Sewer Line Rehabilitation, 95th Avenue and Northern Avenue

Approved Contract Amendment No. 2 in an amount not-to-exceed \$162,179 with Project Engineering Consultants, Ltd. (PEC) to evaluate an additional mile of sewer line on Northern Avenue and to inspect 70 sanitary sewer manholes on 95th Avenue and Northern Avenue in order to complete the rehabilitation design. 9C Contract Amendment, Sundt Construction, Inc., Butler Drive Water Reclamation Facility Construction

- a) Approved Contract Amendment No. 3 in an amount not-to-exceed \$281,601 with Sundt Construction, Inc. to provide additional work on the Butler Drive Water Reclamation Facility needed to complete project construction (LCON03306C); and
- b) Authorized a budget transfer within the project in the amount of \$55,414 from the Wastewater Bonds, Land Account to the Wastewater Bonds, Wastewater Systems Account.

10C Contract Amendment, MGC Contractors, Inc., Jomax Water Reclamation Facility Expansion

Approved the City's portion of Contract Amendment No. 5 with MGC Contractors, Inc. for a Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) of \$82,948 for construction services for Phase 2 of the Jomax Water Reclamation Facility expansion project (LCON08006E).

11C Budget Adjustment, Public Works Department, Fuel Costs

Approved a budget adjustment in the amount of \$225,000 from the General Fund Contingency Account to pay for increased fuel costs for Fleet Services.

20R PUBLIC HEARING – Liquor Licenses, Various Locations

PUBLIC HEARING: Mayor Barrett opened the Public Hearing and asked if any Councilmember or citizen wished to comment on requests for:

- a) A new Restaurant Liquor License (Series 12) for 3 Tomatoes & a Mozzarella, located at 8258 W. Thunderbird Road Suite 206. Applicant: Jeffrey H. Roskin. LL#10011969; and
- b) A new Restaurant Liquor License (Series 12) for Restaurant Satara Thai Cuisine Boutique Wine Lounge, located at 8350 W. Paradise Lane. Applicant: Randy D. Nations. LL#10012004.

Staff Report/Public Comment:

Mary Jo Kief, City Clerk, reported that the properties had been posted in accordance with Arizona law, all fees were paid, all reviewing Departments recommended approval, and no comments were received from the public.

Having no request from the public to address this item, Mayor Barrett declared the public hearing closed.

Council Action:

Councilmember Evans inquired as to whether the Council could approve the Liquor License for Satara Thai Cuisine given that one of the applications does not bear the signature of the applicant.

Steve Kemp, City Attorney, advised that the application should be held over to another Council Meeting, pending signature of the applicant.

Councilmember Evans requested that the two properties requesting Liquor Licenses be considered separately.

Motion was made by Councilmember Evans, seconded by Councilmember Leone, to recommend approval to the State Liquor Board for:

- a) A new Restaurant Liquor License (Series 12) for 3 Tomatoes & a Mozzarella, located at 8258 W. Thunderbird Road Suite 206. Applicant: Jeffrey H. Roskin. LL#10011969.

Upon vote, the motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Councilmember Evans, seconded by Councilmember Aames to carry over consideration of the request to approve the Liquor License for:

- b) A new Restaurant Liquor License (Series 12) for Restaurant Satara Thai Cuisine Boutique Wine Lounge, located at 8350 W. Paradise Lane. Applicant: Randy D. Nations. LL#10012004.

Upon vote, the motion to carry over carried unanimously.

21R Intergovernmental Agreement Amendment, Peoria Unified School District, Facility Use

Terry Ellis, City Manager, commented on the relationship between Peoria Unified School District (PUSD) and the City of Peoria. Mr. Ellis stated that the agreement before the Council is indicative of the type of relationship shared between the City of Peoria and PUSD. Mr. Ellis stated this agreement came about in an attempt to address problems related to quick growth in population.

J.P. de la Montaigne, Community Services Director, addressed the Council stating that Mr. Ellis assisted in the establishment of an Intergovernmental Agreement in 1999 between PUSD and the City of Peoria. This agreement is to allow the City of Peoria to continue to use 20 elementary schools and 4 high schools for recreation programs and in turn, the City of Peoria waives the fees for PUSD when new schools are built. The Parks and Recreation Board unanimously recommended this agreement and it will go before the School Board at their next meeting.

Vice Mayor Carlat inquired if the City of Peoria was permitted to use new schools as they are built, or does the contract need to be amended before they can be used. Mr. de la Montaigne stated all new schools are included in the contract.

Councilmember Evans inquired as to whether utility costs during the summer months were included within the agreement. Mr. de la Montaigne informed all utility costs are included in the agreement; however, there may be some out-of-pocket costs mainly for fuel expenses for the buses during the summer months.

Motion was made by Vice Mayor Carlat, seconded by Councilmember Hunt to authorize the City Manager to execute an updated Intergovernmental Agreement with the Peoria Unified School District for development processing, general cooperation and facility use (LCON02299A). Upon vote, the motion carried unanimously.

22R Intergovernmental Agreement, Arizona Department of Transportation, Skunk Creek Multi-Use Pathway and Underpass, 83rd Avenue and Rio Vista Community Park

J.P. de la Montaigne, Community Services Director, addressed the Council reminding that one of the top priorities of the Council this year was trail development. Trail construction is currently going on between Olive Avenue and Grand Avenue as the Council previously approved, to connect to the Rio Vista Park trail.

Kirk Haines, Parks Manager, addressed the Council stating that this request will provide a critical link to connect our trails to other trails within the Valley. Mr. Haines provided an overview of the existing trails and the trails that are planned.

Motion was made by Councilmember Aames, seconded by Vice Mayor Carlat to:

- a) Approve an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) for the development of a multi-use pathway and underpass along Skunk Creek, between 83rd Avenue and Rio Vista Community Park (LCON13008); and
- b) Authorize expenditure in the amount of \$252,571 to ADOT for matching funds for the project.

Upon vote, the motion carried unanimously.

CALL TO PUBLIC: (NON-AGENDA ITEMS)

Dolores Ceballos addressed the Council and expressed her opinion about the City Logo "Naturally Connected" being copyrighted by another company that also uses that logo. Ms. Ceballos also expressed appreciation to Councilmembers Aames and Leone for their comments during the Study Session related to the logo and for Mayor Barrett's willingness to have further discussion about the logo.

Reports from the City Manager:

1. Neighborhood Traffic Management Program (NTMP) – Annual Report for the Year 2007

Steve McKenzie, Transportation Planning Engineer, reported he would like to have a streamlined policy for the NTMP that would allow the City of Peoria to work with neighborhoods quicker and to make it more effective for the residents. Mr. McKenzie informed the Council that in 2007, the following was accomplished:

- Reduced the time a project is on the waiting list; currently there is no waiting list.
- Trained and transitioned the new NTMP Project Manager
- Reviewed and evaluated current NTMP policies and procedures
- Implemented and tested some new procedures
- Explored traffic calming options for collector roadways.

Mr. McKenzie reported that the 2008 goals are as follows:

- Reduce waiting lists
- Implement speed cushions on collector roadways
- Propose policy and procedure changes to enable the program to be more efficient for the general public, and to help residents to be more successful in bringing projects to fruition, as well as implementing policies that better serve the needs of individual neighborhoods.

Councilmember Aames inquired as to whether tests are done after the implementation of traffic calming measures to determine the successfulness of the implementation. Mr. McKenzie explained that the standard procedure is to do a before and after study to compare and ensure the devices are functioning properly and that they have the affect that the neighborhood was looking for. In response to further questions from Councilmember Aames, Mr. Mckenzie reported that the typical results of an after-implementation study are favorable in that there is typically a reduction in speed and sometimes in volume as well.

Mayor Barrett inquired about the time-loss for emergency vehicles going over the speed cushions. Mr. McKenzie reported that fire trucks were tested and able to go over the speed cushions at approximately 25 miles per hours resulting in no time loss.

Reports from City Council:

Councilmember Leone reported on the various City of Peoria activities he attended.

Councilmember Evans reminded that school is out this week and the streets will be filled with children playing and requested that everyone drive safely.

Reports from the Mayor:
