

MINUTES OF THE PEORIA CITY COUNCIL

A **Special Meeting and Study Session** of the City Council of the City of Peoria, Arizona was convened at 8401 West Monroe Street in open and public session at 4:01 p.m.

CONSENT – New Business:

1C Authorization to Hold an Executive Session

STUDY SESSION AGENDA

Subjects for Discussion Only:

1. Loop 303 and Lake Pleasant Parkway Development Plan.

Glen Van Nimwegen, Planning and Community Development Director, led the discussion on the proposed infrastructure planning for the Lake Pleasant Parkway and Loop 303 area and outlined the agenda for the presentation. The purpose of the Development Plan is to support the Council's 24-month goals and ensure Lake Pleasant Parkway/Loop 303 becomes an economic development hub. Mr. Van Nimwegen introduced Dave Moody, Project Manager of the engineering study.

Mr. Moody reported on coordinating with the Arizona State Land Department to identify sites suitable for major employment uses. Mr. Moody reviewed the five development phases of the study area that were created based on topography, completion of the Loop 303 and planned Capital Improvement Program (CIP) projects.

Phase 1

Location

- Adjacent to Lake Pleasant Parkway on upper terrace
- Westwing Parkway to north of Loop 303
- 277 acres developable

Tied to

- Completion of Lake Pleasant Parkway
- Extension of water and wastewater lines

Phase 2

Location

- East of Agua Fria River on lower terrace
- North of Dixileta Drive
- 216 acres developable

Tied to

- Completion of Dixileta Drive west of Lake Pleasant Parkway
- Extension of water lines
- Construction wastewater lift station and wastewater lines

Phase 3

Location

- East of Agua Fria River on lower terrace
- South of Loop 303
- 200 acres developable

Tied to

- Construction of 96th Avenue interchange
- Extension of water and wastewater lines

Phase 4

Location

- Adjacent to Lake Pleasant Parkway on upper terrace
- South of Central Arizona Project Canal
- 132 acres developable

Tied to

- Completion of Lake Pleasant Parkway north of Loop 303
- Extension of water and wastewater lines

Phase 5

Location

- East of Agua Fria River on lower terrace
- North of Loop 303
- 365 acres developable

Tied to

- Construction of 96th Avenue interchange
- Extension of 96th Avenue north of Loop 303

Shawn Kreuzwiesner, Utilities Engineering Manager, explained the study area was

planned to ensure that intended land uses could be supported. Mr. Kreuzwiesner provided a timeline for current construction and future expansion of the Loop 303 and construction of Lake Pleasant Parkway south from the Loop 303.

Mr. Van Nimwegen concluded the presentation with an outline of future steps in the process:

- Joint planning efforts with Arizona State Land Department
- Complete Economic Development Strategy
- Open Space Strategy

2. Communications Plan

Carl Swenson, City Manager, introduced Kelly Corsette, Public Information Manager, to discuss the Communications Plan created to strengthen City communication practices.

Mr. Corsette outlined key strategies included in the Plan and highlighted activities within each strategy area.

- Enhance existing communication tools
 - Create and implement graphic standards for City publications
 - Redesign Focus newsletter
 - Continue to improve City Web sites
 - Refresh Peoria Leadership Institute
 - Improve and expand social media presence
- Identify and implement new tools
 - Additional Channel 11 programs to showcase Peoria
 - Regular video news for employees
 - Customize Web site for mobile devices
- Improve working relationships
 - Continue to improve media relationships
 - Communications calendar
- Establish performance measures
 - Web trends
 - Media tracking database
- Align activities with organizational priorities
 - Develop story list to support City Council priorities
 - Internal communication to support Organization Strategic Plan

Mr. Corsette presented a mock-up of the Peoria Focus newsletter in a redesigned format.

Discussion ensued regarding the proposed format. Mr. Corsette advised Council that the proposed improvements would not increase the cost of producing the newsletter.

Mr. Corsette concluded the presentation with a summary of the next steps regarding

communications:

- Citywide communications review is underway
- Internal survey data being used to improve internal communications
- Additional Web discussion and improvements are planned

3. Peoria Leadership Institute

Kelly Corsette, Public Information Manager, provided a brief overview of the Peoria Leadership Institute. The Leadership Institute is an outreach and orientation program that provides an in-depth look at City government and offers an opportunity for citizens to meet City staff and elected officials.

Mr. Corsette advised that the program was reviewed to ensure it contains the best possible content for participants. Mr. Corsette summarized proposed changes to the program. Information would be presented from a service/topic perspective, rather than department-by-department. By focusing the discussion, the same amount of information could be presented in fewer sessions.

Proposed sessions include:

- Session 1: Managing the City and its Finances
- Session 2: Fire, Emergency Response and Preparedness
- Session 3: Community Policing and the Courts
- Session 4: Building Community and Total Planning
- Session 5: Play Peoria: Recreation, Arts & Culture
- Session 6: Service Hits the Streets
- Session 7: City Council Roundtable & Graduation
