SUBJECT: Community Works Wall Enhancements

SUMMARY:

Work has begun on the right of way wall enhancements. The areas listed below have received the initial stucco treatment. The walls will be painted to match the surrounding neighborhoods.

- West side of 75th Ave., between Hearn and Calavar
- North side of Cactus Road, between 75th and 73rd
- Both the east and west sides of 83rd Ave., between Windrose and Columbine

Since the block walls are owned by several residents, staff was required to seek permission from each individual in order to complete the stucco improvements. We are still waiting on responses from residents along Peoria Ave, where we are planning to treat the north wall between Cotton Crossings and 79th Ave., and the south side of Peoria Ave. between 75th Ave. and 77th Ave.

The City of Peoria's Graffiti Technician, Ken Nelson, has painted the following walls to match the surrounding neighborhoods.

- North side of Cactus Road, between 77th and 75th
- West side of 75th Ave., between Sweetwater and Thunderbird.
- Both the east and west sides of 87th Ave., between Cactus and Sweetwater
- Both sides of various portions of 75th Ave., between Cactus and Olive are being painted at this time.

All scheduled work is expected to be completed in February 2009.
