SUBJECT: Amendment to Peoria Police Officer's Association (P.P.O.A.),
Memorandum of Understanding (M.O.U.), July 1, 2008 to June 30,
2010.

RECOMMENDATION:

Discussion and possible action by the Mayor and City Council to approve the attached amendment to the current Memorandum of Understanding (M.O.U.) with the Peoria Police Officer's Association (P.P.O.A.), two year contract, FY 2009-2010.

SUMMARY:

The current Memorandum of Understanding (M.O.U.) between the City of Peoria and the Peoria Police Officer's Association (P.P.O.A.) is a two year contract beginning July 1, 2008 and ending June 30, 2010 with a base wage only re-opener for the second year.

The City is making this change to the M.O.U. due to the current economic condition and is consistent with the lack of wage increases for all other employees. The change to the current M.O.U. is as follows:

Article 3: Wages

Notwithstanding anything contained in this Memorandum of Understanding (dated July 2008 through June 2010 between the City of Peoria and Peoria Police Officers Association), the Association and the City agree that the operation of Article 3, subsection 6 titled Merit Increase shall be suspended for the period commencing on July 1, 2009 and ending on the termination date of this Memorandum of Understanding

RESOLUTION NO. 09-84A

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PEORIA, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA INCLUDING ADDITIONAL LANGUAGE IN THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE PEORIA POLICE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION AND THE CITY PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION 09-45 DECLARING A FISCAL CRISIS AND ESTABLISHING POLICIES AND PROCEDURES GOVERNING WAGES, HOURS AND CONDITIONS OF WORK FOR POLICE OFFICERS EMPLOYED IN THE PEORIA POLICE DEPARTMENT BASED ON A DETERMINATION OF THE APPROPRIATE ACTION IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST INCLUDING THAT OF THE EMPLOYEES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY OR ALTERNATE EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on February 8, 1988 the Peoria City Council adopted Ordinance No. 88-13 formally recognizing the Peoria Police Officers Association ("PPOA") as the designated representative for Police Officers and establishing a formalized framework for employer-employee relations between the City and PPOA;

WHEREAS, the Peoria City Council has amended the Ordinance No. 88-13 from time to time ("PPOA Ordinance"), and some of the generally applicable provisions of the PPOA Ordinance have been codified in Peoria City Code §§ 19-16 through -21;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the PPOA Ordinance, the City and PPOA have entered into successive Memoranda of Understanding ("MOU") governing the wages, hours, and working conditions for Peoria Police Officers;

WHEREAS, in 2008, the City and PPOA entered into the latest MOU governing the time period of July 1, 2008 – June 30, 2009;

WHEREAS, it is expected that both parties in good faith and fair dealing are authorized by their respective principals to negotiate and agree and will in good faith recommend to their respective principals the agreement that they have executed;

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Peoria on April 21, 2009 adopted a resolution declaring a fiscal crisis (Resolution 09-45) and authorizing the City Manager to commence negotiations with the PPOA regarding changes to the adopted Memorandum of Understanding between the City and PPOA;

WHEREAS, the parties reached a tentative agreement that was submitted to the membership of the PPOA for ratification and the membership has elected not to ratify such tentative agreement.

WHEREAS, the PPOA President informed the City on or after June 5, 2009 that the PPOA membership had voted to not approve the tentative agreement amending the MOU;

WHEREAS, after a tentative agreement amending the Memorandum of Understanding pursuant to a fiscal crisis declaration has been rejected and negotiations ended, the City Council is vested with the legal authority to take such action as deems appropriate in the public interest, including that of the employees in question, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the public interest, including but not limited to the interest of the employees that are represented by the Peoria Police Officers Association to protect and mitigate the fiscal crisis involving the City as follows:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Peoria as follows:

SECTION 1. Wage Package. That the City shall adopt the following provision governing wages, holidays, uniform allowances and hours of work, as set forth in Appendix A, commencing on July 1, 2009.

SECTION 2. Term and Effect.

A. This Resolution will remain in full force and effect commencing on its effective date and will automatically terminate on June 30, 2010, unless extended by the Peoria City Council.

B. The City Council reserves its right to amend, modify, repeal or enact additional legislation pertaining to this matter as it deems appropriate in the public interest.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall be effective through June 30, 2010. This Resolution shall become effective on one of the following two dates:

A. If a sufficient number of the Mayor and Councilmembers present vote that an EMERGENCY exists because the immediate operation of the provisions of this Resolution is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Peoria, then this Resolution shall be in full force and effect beginning on the first day of July 1, 2009, and the Resolution is hereby exempt from the referendum provision of the Constitution and laws of the State of Arizona.

B. If a sufficient number of the Mayor and Councilmembers present do not vote to declare that an emergency exists, then this Resolution shall become effective in the manner provided by law, however all provisions shall be retroactive to July 1, 2009.
