SUBJECT: Acceptance of 2009 Homeland Security Grant Funds from the Arizona Department of Homeland Security in the amount of \$118,786.

RECOMMENDATION: Discussion and possible action to (a) approve the acceptance of four (4) State of Arizona Department of Homeland Security (AZDHS) grants awarded to the Fire Department for the sustainment of the chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear, explosive (CBRNE) response and detection program, Terrorism Liaison Officer (TLO) program, Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) program, and the enhancement of Fire's mass casualty decontamination unit; and (b) authorize a budget transfer from Proposed Grants Fund Proposed Grants Division contingency (7990-7990-570000) to Homeland Security Grant Fund 7670, Homeland Security Division 7870 (various accounts) in order to establish an appropriation so that the department may accept and expend these funds.

SUMMARY: The City of Peoria Fire Department has been working collaboratively for several years with various jurisdictions in the region to develop and integrate a statewide disaster response program. In July of 2009, the Fire Department finalized their award of \$750,000 for a medium duty CBRNE response vehicle and associated decontamination equipment. The department just received a FY09 award for \$80,000 from the Urban Area Strategic Initiative (UASI) to enhance and support this program with additional decontamination equipment, personal protective equipment, and equipment maintenance.

The department also received an award of \$16,245 from the State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSGP) to enhance and support the Peoria Fire Department's mass

casualty and decontamination units, which are statewide deployable assets. This grant provides funding for medical supplies, pharmaceuticals, and logistical equipment.

An additional \$4,000 was awarded for the sustainment of TLO program through UASI and \$18,541 was awarded through SHSGP to support the department's CERT program with funding for training and equipment.


