SUBJECT: Acceptance of 2010 Homeland Security Grant Funds from the Arizona Department of Homeland Security in the amount of \$253,493.

RECOMMENDATION:

Discussion and possible action to (a) accept six (6) State of Arizona Department of Homeland Security (AZDOHS) grants awarded to the City of Peoria Police and Fire Departments for the sustainment and enhancement of the chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear, explosive (CBRNE) response and detection programs for Police and Fire, the Terrorism Liaison Officer (TLO) programs for Police and Fire, Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) program for Fire, and City Hall Campus Target Hardening program for the Police Department; and

(b) authorize a budget transfer from Proposed Grants Division contingency (7990-7990-570000) to Homeland Security Grant Fund 7670-7870 (various accounts) in the amount of \$111,953 for Fire Department grants and \$141,540 to Homeland Security Grant Fund 7545-7795 (various accounts) for the Police Department grants in order to establish an appropriation so that each department may expend these funds.

SUMMARY:

The City of Peoria Police and Fire Departments have been working collaboratively with various jurisdictions in the region to integrate a statewide disaster response program for several years. The Fire Department received FY10 awards in the amounts of \$80,000 from the Urban Area Strategic Initiative (UASI) to enhance and support the CBRNE program, \$5,700 for the sustainment of the TLO program through UASI and \$26,253 through the State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSGP) to support the Fire Department's CERT program.

The Police Department was also awarded \$80,000 from UASI to support and enhance their CBRNE program, \$1,540 from UASI to support and enhance their TLO program and \$60,000 from UASI for City of Peoria Municipal Complex campus target hardening. The target hardening funds will be used to integrate critical infrastructure protection plans and procedures that coordinate the implementation of federal and state standards for the fortification of public and private assets and critical infrastructure.

If your project requires an Environmental and Historic Preservation (EHP) review, this must be completed and approved prior to any expenditure of funds.

All projects that support training initiatives including FEMA approved/state sponsored training must be in compliance with grant guidance, the subgrantee agreement, and approved through the ADEM/AZDOHS training request process prior to execution of training contract.
