Crime in progress – call 911

62,165* 911 calls received last year

65,740 non emergency/ 8311 calls received last year

Communications



Priority 1 Definition A priority one call is any life-threatening call which involves the possibility of death or serious injury, any confrontation between two or more people that could threaten the life or safety of any person; or any call in which the delay in dispatch may compromise the immediate apprehension of a suspect.

Average Response Time: 5.50

Goal:
hold no more than 2 minutes

Communications



Priority 2 Definition In-progress or just occurred calls for service that do not pose an immediate threat to a person's life, safety, or property and where immediate apprehension of a suspect(s) is unlikely. Also includes non-injury traffic accidents or those accidents that create a traffic hazard.

Average Response Time: 11.90

Goal:
hold no more than 10 minutes

Communications



Priority 3 Definition Calls in which there is little or no likelihood of apprehending a suspect, or where life or property is not subject to threat. A delay in response of an officer will not decrease the quality of police service but will provide time management of patrol operations.

Average Response Time: 66.30

Goal:
hold no more than 2 hours

Communications



Priority 4 Definition Non-emergency calls for service that will be assigned to a call-back officer or police services officer. Generally, these calls will be handled by telephone, however, may also include lobby walk-ins, online reports, or counter reports.

Can hold for up to 24 hours
