



**NEIGHBORHOOD STABILIZATION PROGRAM 3  
SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE  
ANNUAL ACTION PLAN**

The City of Peoria received an allocation of \$1.2M grant authorized by Section 1497 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Act of 2010. The Act provides new NSP funds to states and local governments to continue to assist in the redevelopment of abandoned and foreclosed homes. The Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) is treating grantees' use of its NSP3 grant to be a substantial amendment to its current approved annual action plan. As such, grantees are required to submit their substantial amendment to HUD for its grant allocation by March 1, 2011. The substantial amendment is currently in the program design phase and the City is seeking public comment in its design strategies based on local real estate market conditions in neighborhoods that meet HUD's NSP grant requirements.

A public meeting will be held at 6:00 p.m. on December 20, 2010 at the Peoria Community Center located at 8335 W. Washington to receive public comment on the NSP3 program. The draft plan will be published on the City's website at [www.peoriaaz.gov](http://www.peoriaaz.gov) on or about February 1, 2011.
