



ANALYSIS OF IMPEDIMENTS TO FAIR HOUSING CHOICE

The Analysis of Impediments (AI) is a review of impediments to fair housing choice in the City of Peoria, as required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The AI involves: 1) A review of the city's demographic, economic, and housing characteristics; and laws, regulations, and administrative policies, procedures and practices; 2) An assessment of how those laws, policies and practices affect the location availability and accessibility of housing; and an assessment of conditions, both public and private, affecting fair housing choices for all protected classes.

A public meeting will be conducted from 4:30 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. on February 23, 2011 at the City of Peoria, Ironwood Conference Room located on the first floor of City Hall, 8401 W. Monroe, to receive public comment on the Analysis of Impediments to Fair Choice Housing. Residents can also participate in a fair housing survey online at: www.surveymonkey/s/PeoriaFairHousing.
