

Temporary Use Permit Security Plans

Not all Temporary Use Permits will require a written Security Plan. The primary factor that should be taken into consideration by the applicant is the protection of citizens and attendees.

The following criteria should be considered guidelines for when a Security Plan may be needed for a Temporary Use Permit. For definitive requirements, please contact Mike Self, Police Analyst, Peoria Police Department, at 623-773-7082.

Factors for consideration in determining Security Plan requirements:

- Is alcohol being served? (This will require an AZ Dept. of Liquor License and Control permit), if so, a written security plan will likely be required.
- What is the nature of the venue?
- What type of crowd is the venue expected to attract?
- What is the anticipated size of attendance?
- What type of events will be held in conjunction with the main venue?
- What will be the hours of operation?
- What is the location of the venue site?
- What is the size of the venue site?
- What current events may be associated with the venue theme?
- Is the venue impacted by a politically sensitive special interest?
- What is the venue's record for previous events (local)?
- What is the venue's record for previous events (outside of local area)?

Previous events have shown that the first time an event is held will usually set the tone for repeat events; therefore it is important that security is properly addressed before the first time an event is held.
