



# 2013 CITY OF PEORIA Historic Preservation Commission Awards

## I. Purpose

The City of Peoria Historic Preservation Commission Awards program seeks to increase public awareness of Peoria's historic resources, including historic buildings and archaeological resources by recognizing the people, programs, and projects that have helped to preserve Peoria's heritage. Awards may honor individual accomplishments, or may instead recognize an on-going commitment to the preservation and promotion of heritage resources in the City.

## II. Eligible Award Recipients:

1. Individuals, groups, or organizations engaged in historic preservation related activities, as well as specific projects and programs dealing with historic preservation may receive this award.
2. Examples of eligible recipients include:
  - a. Individuals, groups, or organizations who have contributed to preserving Peoria's heritage through their personal involvement in historic preservation / archaeology education, advocacy, or field work.
  - b. On-going programs that promote, preserve, or provide interpretations of Peoria's heritage. This can include publications, presentations, oral history documentation, as well as programs dealing with structural preservation efforts.
  - c. Projects that represent successful preservation, restoration, rehabilitation, or adaptive re-use of historic buildings, structures, sites, and cultural landscapes.

## III. Nomination Requirements:

In order to be accepted for review nominations must include the following:

1. A completed Nomination Application form.
2. A type-written explanation of 500 words or less describing the nominated individual, group, or organization and the activities, program, or project that has made a positive impact on the preservation of Peoria's heritage.
3. At least one color photograph that illustrates the achievements of the nominee (if applicable). Photographs may show the historic resources involved, the results of a project, people involved in a project or program, or community members benefiting from the activities, programs, or projects.

Supplemental information may be provided including any publications that resulted from the program or project, or any media coverage such as news articles that describe the nominated persons, programs, or projects. Individuals or organizations may nominate themselves and their own projects and programs. Materials may be condensed for the Commission's review.

Nomination packages must be received by the Planning Division no later than **February 14, 2013**.

Nomination packages can be submitted by mail or dropped off with planning counter staff at the Development & Community Services Building, located at 9875 N. 85<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Peoria, AZ 85345.

The Historic Preservation Commission will review and consider nominations at their regular meeting on **March 13, 2013**. The commission may choose to confer one or more awards depending on the nature of the nominations received. Award presentations will be held at the Peoria Pioneer Days celebration on **April 6, 2013**.
