

Frequently asked July 4th Questions

When is the Event? Sunday, July 4, 2010

What time is the Event? Gates open at 5 p.m.
Fireworks begin at approximately 9:15 p.m.
Event is over at 10 p.m.

Where is the Event? Peoria Sports Complex, 16101 North 83rd Avenue
Mariners Practice Fields and the Main Stadium

What does it cost to get in? Children 12 and under are free
Age 13 and "Wiser" \$5.00 per person

What does it cost to park? Nothing...it is free!

What can I bring into the event? Lawn chairs, blankets and food and non-alcoholic beverages are permitted

What is not allowed at the event?

- **NO ALCOHOL**
- **No glass containers of any kind**
- **No portable canopies**
- **No bicycles**
- We recommend leaving pets at home, service animals are permitted.

What time are the fireworks going to go off? Approximately 9:15 p.m.

Will alcohol be served at the event? Yes, beer will be available on-site in the main stadium and practice fields
