



The following memo is a description of the submittal requirements for New Stand Alone Building Plans only (i.e. shell buildings, commercial buildings, office/warehouse shell buildings, etc.), NO Tenant Improvements. Read the information carefully to ensure you have all of the appropriate forms and information for the submittal.

SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW STAND ALONE BUILDINGS

Engineering (Preliminary) documents according to BTR requirements (Arizona Board of Technical Registration) are required to be included in all of the building plan sets for the following system(s) to obtain the appropriate building permit.

- Automatic Fire Sprinkler Systems
- Fire Alarm Systems

Deferred Shop Drawing submittals, based on the Engineering (Preliminary) documents, are required by the installing contractor for the following system(s) to obtain the appropriate permit(s) for installation and/or modification of the system(s).

- Automatic Fire Sprinkler Systems
- Fire Alarm Systems
- Kitchen Hood Fire Suppression Systems
- Special Hazard Fire Suppression Systems
- Underground Fire Lines

It should be noted that no inspections may take place beyond the frame inspection until the fire alarm, fire sprinkler, kitchen fire suppression system, special hazard fire suppression system and/or the underground fire line contractor(s) obtain their own permits.

Any person, corporation, partnership or other entity engaged in the business of design, install, monitor, sell, or service fire protection equipment within the city of Peoria shall, obtain a permit from the fire department. A copy of the business permit shall be submitted with the shop drawing submittals.
