## Outdoor Public Art

An artist is being sought to design outdoor artwork for placement at the Sunrise Mountain Library. Appropriate projects include painted mural, sculptures, mobile, sculptural relief, and other similar art objects. Proposals should also identify exact location, lighting, and mounting and installation suggestions relating to the site. ## Budget

The total art budget for the project is one hundred thousand (\$100,000) for a single or multiple works of art. This amount must cover the artist's design services and all costs related to artwork. Including materials, site preparation, labor, construction, transportation, storage, installation, lighting, as well as the artist's liability insurance during the period of art production and installation.

## Application Guidelines

### APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The following application materials are due at the Peoria Arts Commission. 8463 W Monroe Street, Peoria, AZ 85345, by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, October 14, 2009.

1. Statement of interest, qualifications and ideas for the project (not to exceed two pages, 8-1/2" by 11").
2. Resume or bibliographical summary focusing on the applicant's career as an artist and past experience (not to exceed two pages, 8-1/2" by 11")
3. A CD-ROM with eight to twenty digital photographs in JPEG or Bitmap format
4. A list shall accompany the CD-ROM and include the photograph number and description of the photographs submitted including title, year, location (City, project sponsor, and building), medium and dimensions.
5. Optional - artist may include two sketches or ideas for the project on 8-1/2" by 11")

### SELECTION PROCEDURE

The Peoria Arts Commission has established a selection committee to review the submitted application materials and make a recommendation to the City. The Peoria Arts Commission will review the committee's suggestions and then make its project recommendations to the full City Council for action. The general public will have an opportunity to view and comment on the winning art design proposal which will be on display at Sunrise Mountain Library from December 17 to December 30, 2009. The general public will also have an another opportunity to provide feedback on the project and recommended proposal at the City Council meeting on January 13, 2010.

### FINALISTS

The selection committee will invite up to three semi-finalists to develop complete proposals. Prior to submitting proposals, semi-finalists will be required to attend a pre-proposal meeting and site visit to obtain a better understanding about the project. Proposals must include either a drawing or model, plus specific information on scale, medium, installation, and complete budget. Semi-finalists are also required to make a presentation of their proposals. Each semi-finalist will receive a \$1,500 stipend to compensate for out-of-pocket costs associated with the competition. The stipend shall cover all proposal-related costs such as models, drawings, and travel to and from Peoria.

## Project Criteria

**Criteria for evaluating the finalists' proposals are as follows:**

- A. Artistic merit and quality of artwork
- B. Artist's past experience or "track record" of producing commissions of similar size, cost, artistic media, etc.
- C. Likelihood that the artist can produce the art product in the given time period, budget, and guidelines.
- D. Sensitivity of the proposal to the site, surroundings, and Peoria's image
- E. Attention to durability and maintenance requirements.
- F. Consideration of Peoria's history and "user friendliness."

Arizona artists are encouraged to apply.
