I/we understand that medical claims are my/our responsibility. This waiver does not extend to any such claim or liability that is caused by the sole and exclusive intentional acts or gross negligence of Peoria Unified School District and/or the City of Peoria or its officers, employees, or agents. TEAM PEORIA SPECIAL OLYMPICS STANDARDS OF PARTICIPATION

The City of Peoria Adaptive Recreation Program sponsors a variety of Special Olympic training opportunities. Over the years Team Peoria has seen a tremendous growth in the number of athletes being served. With such a large team it is imperative that both athletes and parents understand and adhere to the Standards of Participation with Team Peoria.

- Athletes must be 8 years of age to train or compete in Special Olympics.
- A completed Special Olympic Medical Release Form must be on file with the Adaptive Recreation Program.
- Athletes need to attend a minimum of 65% of practices in order to be registered for competition.
- Proper equipment must be worn. If athlete does not have the proper equipment it will be provided.
- If an athlete is transported on a city van seat belts must be worn. Misbehavior on the van will lead to terminating that athlete's transportation privilege.
- All athletes are required to be respectful and follow directions given by staff/coach.
- All athletes are expected to display good sportsmanship at all times. Non-sportsmanlike behavior can lead to suspension or removal from the program. This includes comments and gestures made towards other teams as well as teammates. Each incident will be handled on a case by case basis.
- In consideration of staff and volunteers, all athletes are required to be picked up from training or competition locations at the designated times.
- Athletes and parents are expected to support those disciplinary measures deemed necessary and in the best interest of the program.
- Athletes must make a good faith effort to attend practices and must be available to play all days of competition, including competitions that are Monday through Friday, and school days.

These guidelines have been developed so that all athletes and family members have a clear understanding of the standards that will be applied to the program. By adhering to these, Team Peoria will continue to be a place where athletes can participate in a positive, safe and structured environment.
