



Household Hazardous Waste Disposal Collection

Each year, the City of Peoria sponsors hazardous waste drop off events for its active residential trash account customers. Help us keep our environment safe and clean by properly disposing of your unwanted household hazardous waste such as:

- Auto batteries, motor oil, and anti-freeze, flammables, CFL's,
- Paint (5 gallons per household)
- Pesticides and insecticides, pool chemicals
- Four (4) on-road tires (No Rims)
- E-Waste
 - Computers, electronics, Tv's, printers
- Appliances
 - Refrigerators, water heaters, stoves, dishwashers

County Requirements

Peoria is required by Maricopa County to annually inspect customer's trash and recycling barrels. Maricopa County also conducts random inspections. Barrels are tagged only when problems or concerns are noted by inspectors. If you receive a barrel tag, please make the noted corrections to ensure that your barrels can be serviced in a timely manner.



Commercial Services

Peoria provides high quality customer service and refuse collection to commercial businesses at affordable rates.

- Four, six, and eight- yard containers are available to serve any size business.
- Roll-offs are available for both residential and commercial needs to dispose of waste from remodeling, construction or landscaping projects.

Landfill Information

Residents may dispose of bulk items or trash at the Deer Valley Transfer Station or the Northwest Landfill. Proof of residency, such as a utility bill or driver's license is required to dispose of trash at these sites. Christmas Tree Recycling

Solid Waste Services and Special Programs





The City of Peoria provides solid waste services to residents and commercial businesses within the City limits. This brochure provides basic information on solid waste and recycling services and programs.

Loose Trash Cleanup

Once a year, the city offers free pickup of bulky items from your home. Please visit www.peoriaaz.gov/loosetrash for your collection dates and for program guidelines.

NO hazardous waste will be picked up during the Loose Trash Program. Bulky items that exceed the maximum free collection size will incur a special haul charge.

Special Hauls

Special hauls are for resident-generated large or bulky items. Fees for a special haul are based on every 15 minutes of load time.

- Special hauls can be scheduled for the following items: furniture, appliances, wood, and yard clippings, grass, leaves, and tree limbs. Tree limbs must not exceed 4 feet in length and grass/yard clippings must be bagged and tied closed. All items must be neatly stacked and/or bagged for collection. Resident is responsible for cleaning up debris left behind from collecting tree branches, and bags that split open while awaiting pickup.
- There will be an additional fee for large pickups that require the use of a roll-off and/or tractor.
- The special haul fee will be added to your monthly utility billing. Please have your utility account number available when scheduling a special haul.

Dead Animal Pickup

Deceased pets must be placed in a box or wrapped in paper or a cloth, and placed at the curbside. Deceased animals in the street can also be called in for removal. This service excludes livestock, feral animals, and birds.

Bag Central Station

Local grocers and many City facilities have bins to accept plastic bags for recycling. Visit www.BagCentralStation.com for more information.

Residential and Multi-Family Recycling Program

The City of Peoria provides commingled curbside recycling collection to Peoria residents. **DO NOT bag your recyclables – it slows down the sorting process.**

Yes —Acceptable Items:

Paper: newspapers, ads, magazines, phone books, paperback books, envelopes, postcards, catalogs, paper bags, copier paper.

Plastics: #1 through #7 water and beverage bottles, milk jugs, detergent containers, food containers (*yogurt, sour cream, cottage cheese, etc.*), fountain drink cups, disposable clean plates, CD cases, rigid plastics.

Glass: green, brown and clear glass containers and jars.

Aluminum/Metal: beverage cans, pie tins, foil paper, food cans, metal clothes hangers, empty aerosol cans.

Cardboard: shipping, cereal, shoe, frozen food boxes (remove inner bags/materials).

No —Unacceptable Items:

Paper: pet food bags, napkins, plates, facial or sanitary tissue, photographs, hardback books.

Plastics: grocery bags, trash bags, newspaper bags, snack bags, PVC piping, plastic cling wrap, #6 foam products, Styrofoam plates, cups, packing peanuts.

Glass: windows, mirrors.

Hazardous Waste: paint, oil, corrosives, flammables, insecticides, pesticides, batteries.

Yard Waste: grass, tree limbs, other trimmings, construction debris, dirt, rocks.

Household / Auto: garbage bagged and tied; dirty diapers, food waste, pet waste, tires, rims, motor oil.

TIPS

It is our goal to provide Peoria residents with exceptional refuse and recycling services. Please follow these guidelines to ensure your refuse and recycling barrels are serviced in a timely manner.

- Bag and Tie all trash before placing in your refuse barrel. This is a requirement from Maricopa County to control odors, insects, rodents and/or other vectors.
- Place your container at the curbside by 6:00 a.m. on your scheduled collection day. The container must be returned to private property by 6:00 p.m. If you miss the 6 a.m. deadline, we will collect it on your next regularly scheduled collection day. If you require a Special Haul, please call **623-773-7431** for a price quote and to schedule.
- Keep your containers at least five feet away from obstacles on both sides. The container cannot be serviced if it is too close to vehicles, mailboxes, or fences due to risk of damaging items with the truck's gripper arms.
- Keep all debris or recyclables inside the barrels. Nothing should hang outside or stick above the barrel lid. Keep the lid closed to reduce spillage, odors and rodents/insects.
- Please do not load the barrels with dirt, rocks, concrete, or vehicle parts. If these items are in your barrel, the barrel will not be serviced.
- Do not contaminate your recycle barrel with trash.

Facility Tours
