Requirements

- **Age 14 by July 30, 2012.** Non- Rio Vista Pass Holders must attach a copy of birth certificate to the application.
- Completion of a minimum of 60 hours (this allows for a 1-2 week vacation)
- Work 2 days per week (maximum of 4 hours per day)
- Work 2 Saturdays and 2 Sundays throughout the course of the summer

- **Mandatory attendance at:**
 - Orientation on Saturday May 19, 2012 from 10am-12pm
 - Wednesday Brown Bag lunches from 12-1:30pm. (Applicants must attend a minimum of five luncheons from June 6 -July 18. These lunches will often feature a guest speaker and team building activities.)
 - **Save the date: End of Summer Volunteer Party Wednesday July 25th.**
